MLabs will begin offering a Paroxysmal Nocturnal Hemoglobinuria (PNH) Profile test effective September 10, 2025. This test replaces the PNH Marker Panel (order code PLINK) currently sent to Mayo Clinic Laboratories.

<u>Collection Instructions:</u> Collect a **FULL** tube of blood in a yellow top ACD A or B Vacutainer <sup>®</sup> tube (minimum 1.0 mL). (EDTA is acceptable) Send intact specimen at room temperature within 12 hours of collection. DO NOT FREEZE. Specimen should arrive at the Flow Cytometry Laboratory within 72 hours of collection. The following information is **required** on a Hematopathology Consult requisition:

- 1. Relevant clinical history
- 2. Clinical or morphological findings and suspicions
- 3. Date and time of collection
- 4. Phone number and after-hours pager number for ordering physician
